the Little Blue Fairy, that could give you the slip."

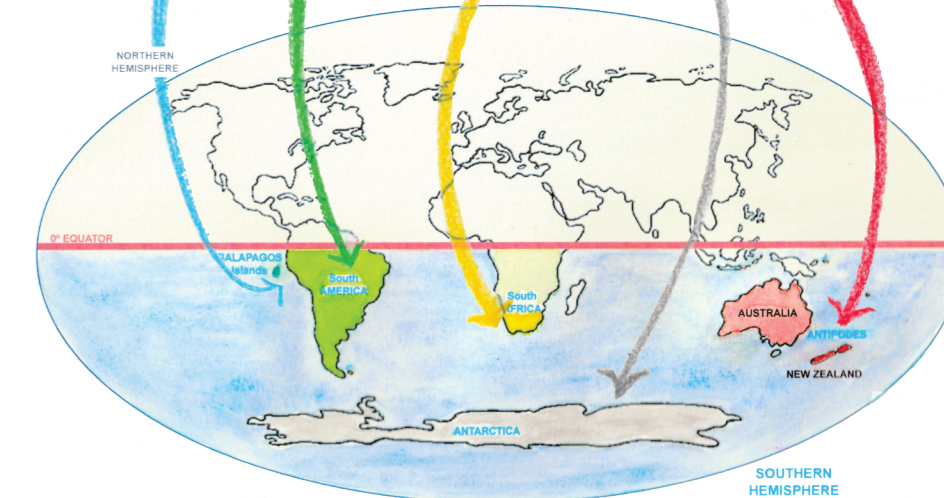


Just then the Queen's fairies were all of a flutter,

and some can tower above him, in height.

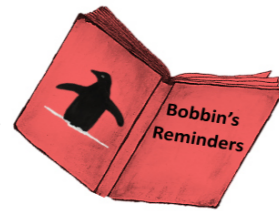


He had no idea there were so many kinds,
